November 2023/January 2024 Regular Board Meeting Highlights



The Board of Directors held the Board meetings on Tuesday, August 28th, and met Tuesday, January 23rd, via Zoom and in-person. The Board and Management would like to thank all of the shareholders who were in attendance.

<u>Management reported the following:</u>

- Budget Prep 2024: The Board motioned to increase carrying charges only by \$5. Notification to the members was mailed out by the office.
- Real Estate Property Taxes: 2nd Installment property taxes were paid on November 7, 2023. The total amount paid in 2023 for tax year 2022, was \$263,375.47. A total of \$271,881.11 was paid out for Senior Exemptions/ Freezes. Grand total tax expense for 2023 was \$535,256.58.
- Smoke & CO Inspections: Smoke & CO detector inspections were scheduled the first week of November. All 386 units were completed.
- ◆ Attic Insulation Project: DNR construction completed phase five of the attic insulation project. It is going very well. Please do not approach the workers. Members should contact the office if they have questions or concerns. DNR construction postponed completing Phase 6 until they receive more grant funding in the 2024 Fiscal Year.
- Surprise! -Euricka informed the board at the January Board Meeting that Tom from DNR construction reached out to inform the community that funds were released. DNR Construction is set to begin Phase 6 at the end of February . Please visit the member page to see the schedule.
- Sales: Management rejected fifteen applications.
 We approved a total of three new members. For the month of November and December combined there were a total of 2 sales & 1 pending.
